

**8** Elvis Presley was a famous American singer, musician, and actor. He was born on January 8 in Mississippi. Elvis was so popular as a singer that people would just call him by his first name. Elvis' music is still played today. He is remembered as The King of Rock 'n Roll.

**15** Martin Luther King Jr. was born on January 15. He was a Civil Rights Leader and his "I Have a Dream" speech is very famous. In 1964, Martin Luther King Jr. was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize. Americans celebrate Martin Luther King Jr. Day as a national holiday every year on the first Monday after Dr. King's actual birthday. In 2019, MLK Day will be on January 21.

**31** Jackie Robinson was the first African-American baseball player in Major League history. He won Rookie of the Year during his first year, 1947, and was an All-Star 6 years in a row. After he died, Jackie Robinson was awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom and the Congressional Gold Medal for his contributions to society and history. He was born on January 31.

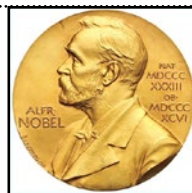
