Change a letter at the beginning.

To really want something to happen.

Take away a letter at the end.

What a rabbit or frog does.

Add a letter at the beginning.

To go to the store and buy things.

Change a letter in the middle.

A really large boat.

Change the *h* to *l* in the middle.

To slide or fall without meaning to.

Change a letter at the end.

Another word for thin or slender.

Change a letter in the middle.

To move, splash, and play in the water.

Change the *m* to *ng* at the end.

To move backward and forward or from side to side.
