Take turns reading, rolling, and chatting about a book that you've read.

To make the dice:

- 1. Cut along the outside edge of the shape below, following the outer solid black lines.
- 2. Fold along the inner black lines, keeping the words to the outside.
- 3. Place glue on the gray sections and fold the cube together. If needed, secure the edges with tape. Print on heavy paper or cardstock to make a sturdier dice (optional).

What was your favorite part of the story? Why?

What lesson did you learn from this story?

To play the game:

- 1. Choose a book. Look at the cover and read the title.
- 2. Read the story to yourself, with a partner, or have someone read the story to you.
- 3. Gently roll the dice on the floor or on the table.
- 4. Read and answer the question on the dice about the story.
- 5. Roll again and answer another question.

Where did this story take place?
