

# COLOR POEM

**Color Poems** use descriptions, nouns, experiences, and the five senses to express feelings about one or more colors. **Color Poems** can be any length, usually do not rhyme, and can contain similes. Danny chose to write a **Color Poem** about his favorite color, red. Use the templates and suggestions below to write a **Color Poem** of your own.

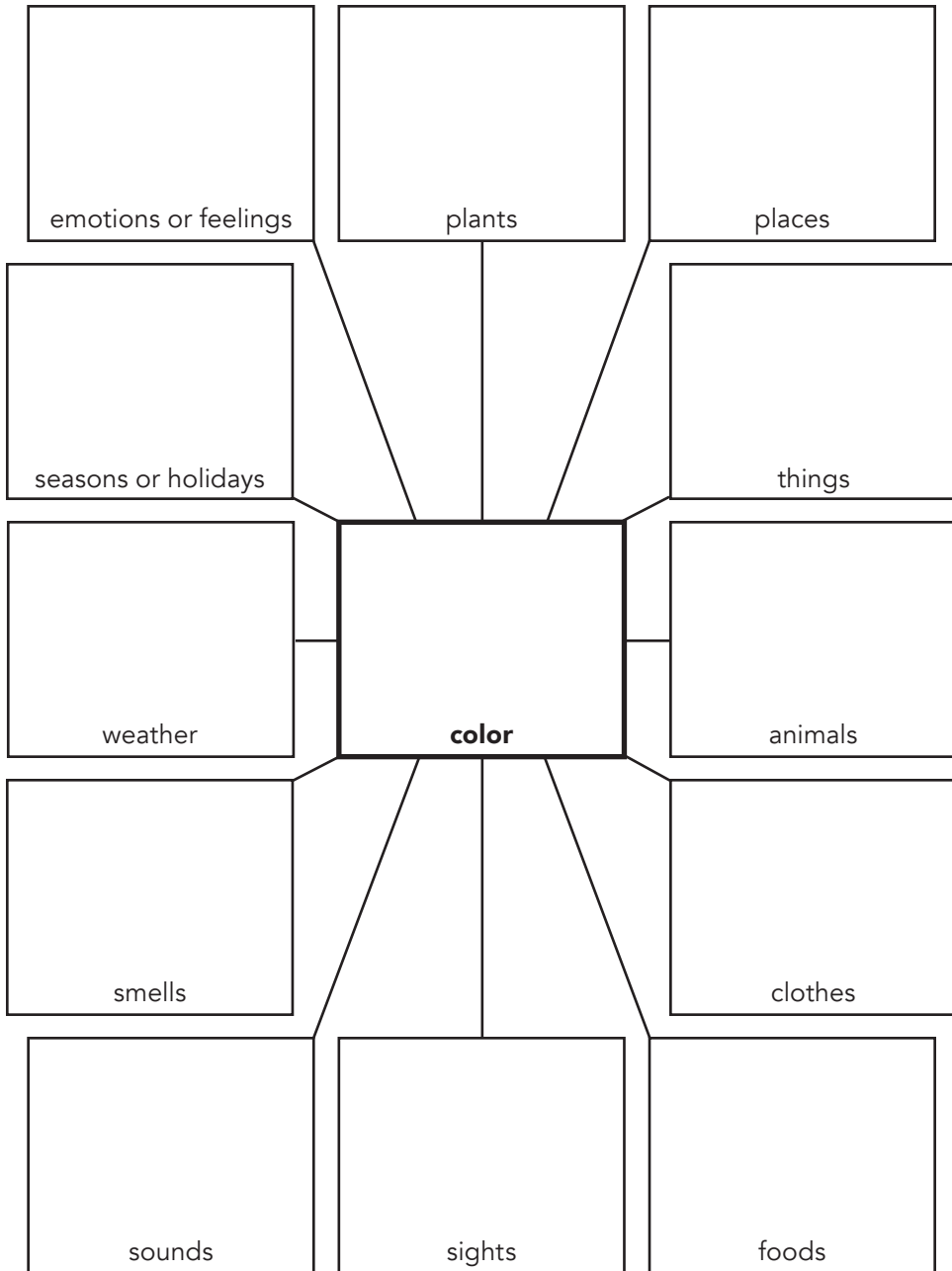
1. Choose a color and brainstorm ideas for your **Color Poem** using the Brainstorming Template. Write words and/or draw pictures of your ideas in each of the boxes.
2. Fill in the **Color Poem** templates. Select your favorite ideas and/or drawings to include in your poem. Decide the order of your ideas and consider the rhythm and flow of your words. Write one poem on the right side of this piece of paper. Cut out your **Color Poem** and glue it into your *Poetry Notebook*.
3. What else can you do with your **Color Poem**?
  - Illustrate your poem.
  - Create your own book. Read *Danny Likes Red* for inspiration.
  - Transform your **Rainbow Poem** into an actual rainbow. On a sheet of paper, draw a rainbow with a line for each color in your poem. Write each line of your poem onto the corresponding color of the rainbow. Glue your **Rainbow Poem** in your *Poetry Notebook*.
  - Turn your poem into a guessing game. Have somebody else read your poem out loud, and instead of saying the color, change it to "This color..." After reading the poem, let the listeners guess the color.
